The research of Dr. Nihat Ali Özcan and Erdem Gürkaynak sheds light on the question of "who are these armed people on the mountain?"

I hope that this research will be useful for those who want to see Turkey's most important problem in a human-centered view without entering into great political debates.

This research, which was also presented to the Human Rights Inquiry Committee of The Turkish Grand National Assembly on February 8, 2012, reflects some of our painful social realities. The most striking aspects of the investigation are the findings about "the child soldiers" who are under the age of 18.

We present this research with the hope that future generations in this country live in a more peaceful environment.

Who are these armed people on the mountain?

On any given topic, it is far easier to find data than it used to be. As researchers, our most

significant task in this new environment is to transform ourselves from data collectors to data

hunters. This is what we tried to achieve in this study. We proceeded to "hunt" the useful figures

from the sea of data and reached some interesting conclusions. We thought that it would be a good

idea to share our findings with everyone and received great interest. For instance, when we

presented this information to the Human Rights Inquiry Committee of The Turkish Grand National

Assembly, their reactions were quite positive.

We have, of course, analyzed the data and came to conclusions of our own. But sometimes even

numbers and graphs by themselves are striking enough to exhibit a situation. We chose this as our

method, thinking it best for those who are interested in this issue to establish their own relations

among the pieces of data.

This research encompasses 1362 PKK Terror Organization Militants who lost their lives between

the years of 2001 and 2011. In this context, you can find information and data about the gender,

birthplace, recruitment age, place of recruitment, year of recruitment, place of death, service time in

the PKK and participation ratios of Militants.





- Of those 1362 PKK members, 1196 are men and 166 are women.


#### **GENDER DISTRIBUTION OF PKK MILITANTS**




#### DISTRIBUTION OF PKK MILITANTS ACCORDING TO THEIR COUNTRY OF BIRTH




### GENDER DISTRIBUTION OF PKK MILITANTS ACCORDING TO THE COUNTRY OF THEIR BIRTH






#### DISTRIBUTION OF PKK MILITANTS ACCORDING TO THEIR PROVINCE OF BIRTH




#### GENDER DISTRIBUTION OF MILITANTS ACCORDING TO THEIR PROVINCE OF BIRTH




#### DISTRIBUTION OF MILITANTS BY BIRTH PLACE ON THE MAP OF TURKEY









### GENDER DISTRIBUTION OF PKK MILITANTS ACCORDING TO THEIR REGION OF BIRTH











### DISTRIBUTION OF TERRORISTS ACCORDING TO THEIR COUNTRY IN WHICH THEY JOINED THE PKK








### DISTRIBUTION OF PKK MILITANTS ACCORDING TO THEIR PROVINCE OF RECRUITMENT







#### **DISTRIBUTION OF PKK MILITANTS BY REGION OF RECRUITMENT**








#### DISTRIBUTION OF PKK MILITANTS BY YEAR OF RECRUITMENT






### DISTRIBUTION OF PKK MILITANTS IN TURKEY AND ABROAD BY YEAR OF RECRUITMENT




#### DISTRIBUTION OF PKK MILITANTS ACCORDING TO THEIR COUNTRY OF DEATH








### DISTRIBUTION OF PKK TERRORISTS ACCORDING TO THEIR REGION OF DEATH (IN TURKEY)




#### **DISTRIBUTION OF PKK TERRORISTS' DEATHS BY YEAR**




### DISTRIBUTION OF PKK TERRORISTS ACCORDING TO THEIR YEAR OF DEATH IN TURKEY AND ABROAD




### GENDER DISTRIBUTION OF PKK TERRORISTS ACCORDING TO THEIR YEAR OF DEATH




### GENDER DISTRIBUTION OF PKK TERRORISTS ACCORDING TO THEIR YEAR OF DEATH (IN TURKEY)




### DISTRIBUTION OF PKK MILITANTS ACCORDING TO THEIR YEAR OF DEATH (ABROAD)








#### **DISTRIBUTION OF PKK TERRORIST DEATHS BY SEASON**






#### **DISTRIBUTION OF PKK TERRORISTS BY MONTH OF DEATH**




### DISTRIBUTION OF PKK TERRORISTS ACCORDING TO THEIR MONTH OF DEATH IN TURKEY AND ABROAD



### DISTRIBUTION OF TERRORISTS ACCORDING TO THEIR SERVICE TIME IN THE PKK





#### DISTRIBUTION OF PKK MILITANTS BY THEIR AGE OF DEATH




### GENDER DISTRIBUTION OF PKK MILITANTS ACCORDING TO THEIR AGE OF DEATH









### COMPRASION BETWEEN PROVINCE OF BIRTH AND PROVINCE OF RECRUITMENT (IN TURKEY)











- The youngest PKK recruit was nine years old.

- The longest period of membership in the PKK is 28 years.




















**Labor Force Participation Rate-TÜİK 2010** 




**Employment Ratio-TÜİK 2010** 






