Peter Mihok

He earned his PhD in the field of East-West economic relations from the University of Economics in Bratislava. Mr. Mihok assigned to various high-level positions both in business life as well as on behalf of Slovak Republic.

He acted as the Plenipotentiary Minister of the Slovak government for European Communities and was the chief negotiator of the Slovak Republic in Brussels during Association Agreement negotiations between Slovak Republic and the European Union. He is now the President of the Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) for Slovakia.

Peter Mihok is currently acting as the President of Slovak Chamber of Commerce and Industry (since 1992), Vice Chairman of World Chambers Federation (WCF ICC/Paris), as well as the Vice President of Eurochambers. Mr. Mihok was awarded with many state awards from Belgium, France, Austria, and Italy. He is multi-lingual in five languages including English, French, German, Russian, and Slovak.
