



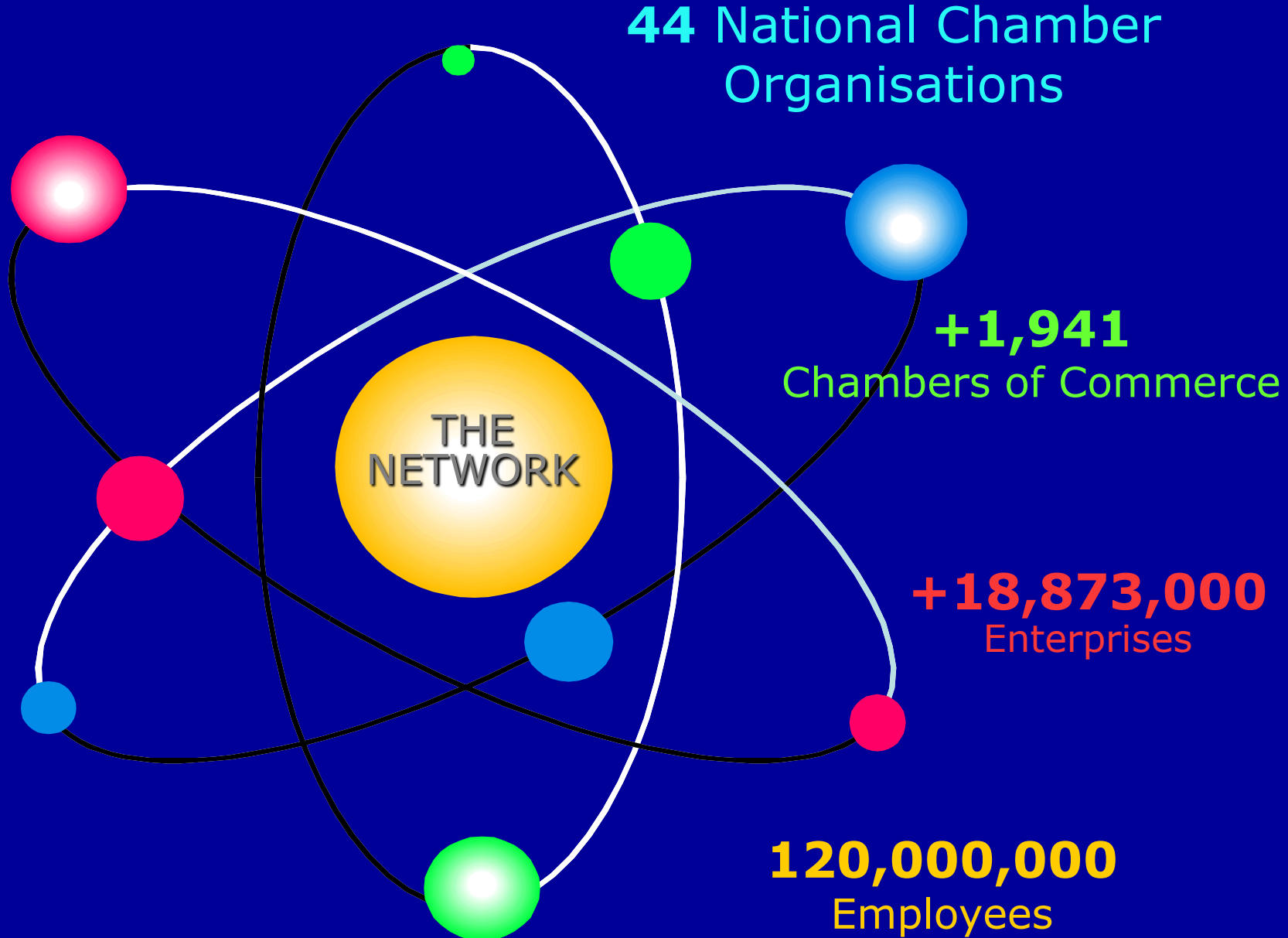

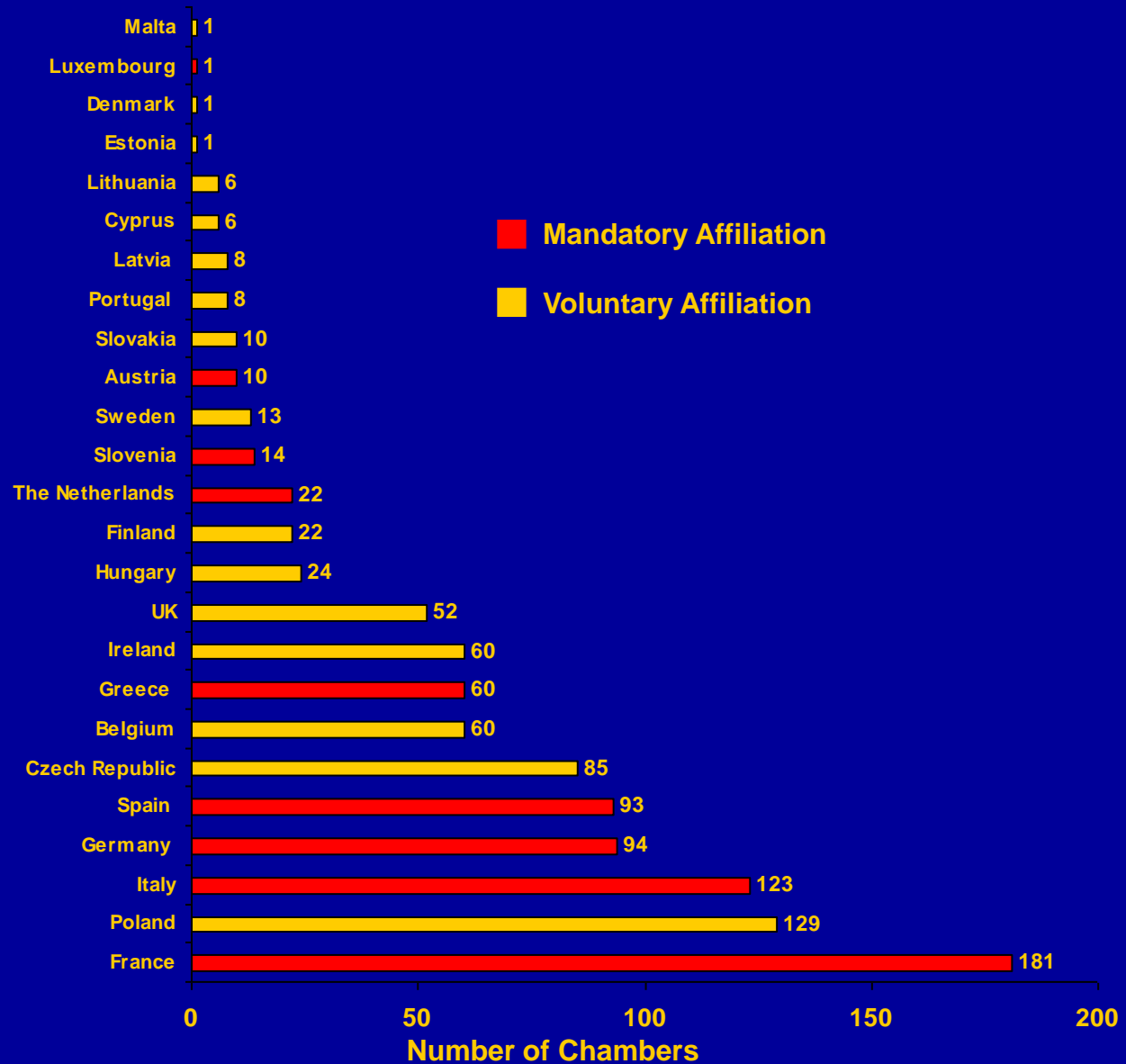

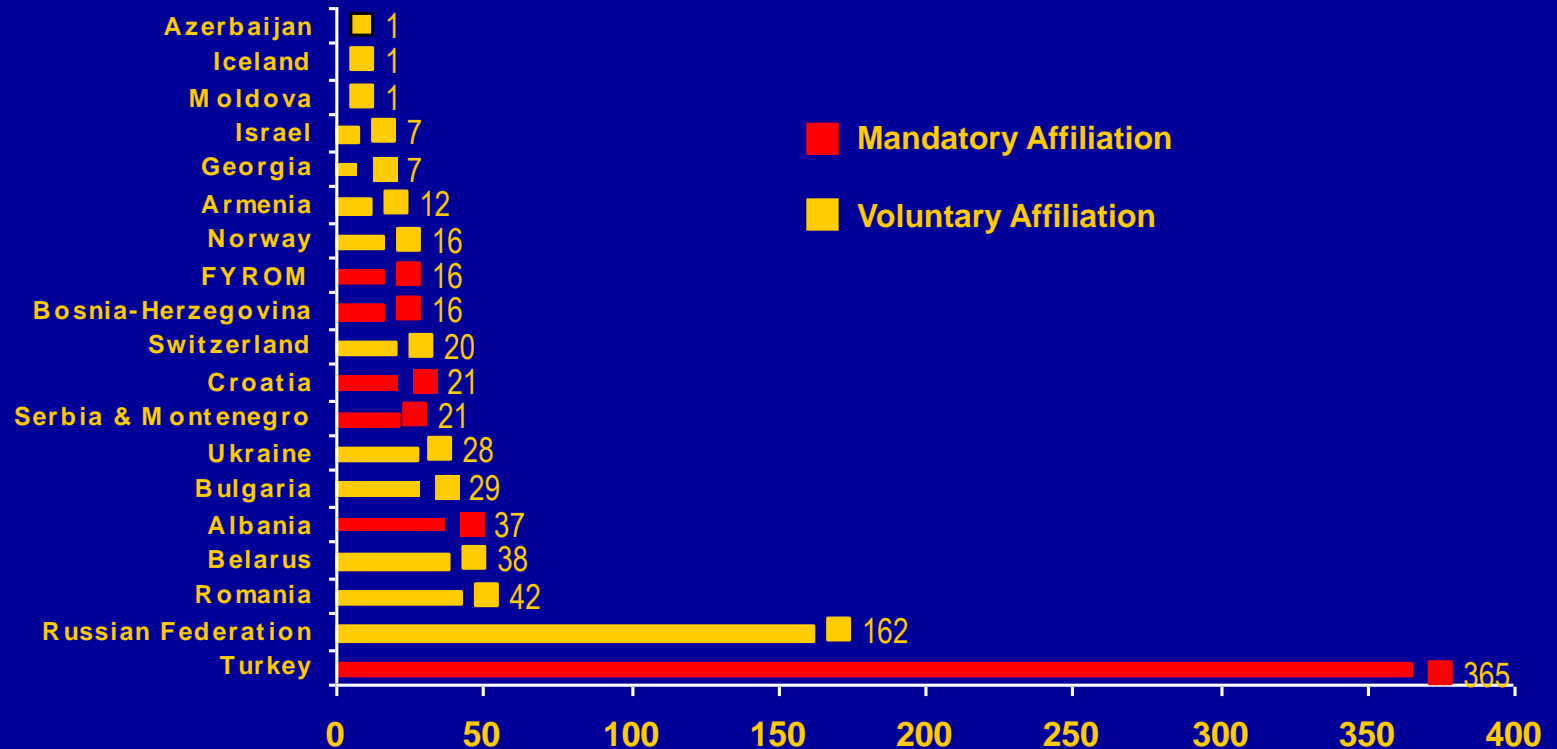


EU 25: 1,048 Chambers of Commerce

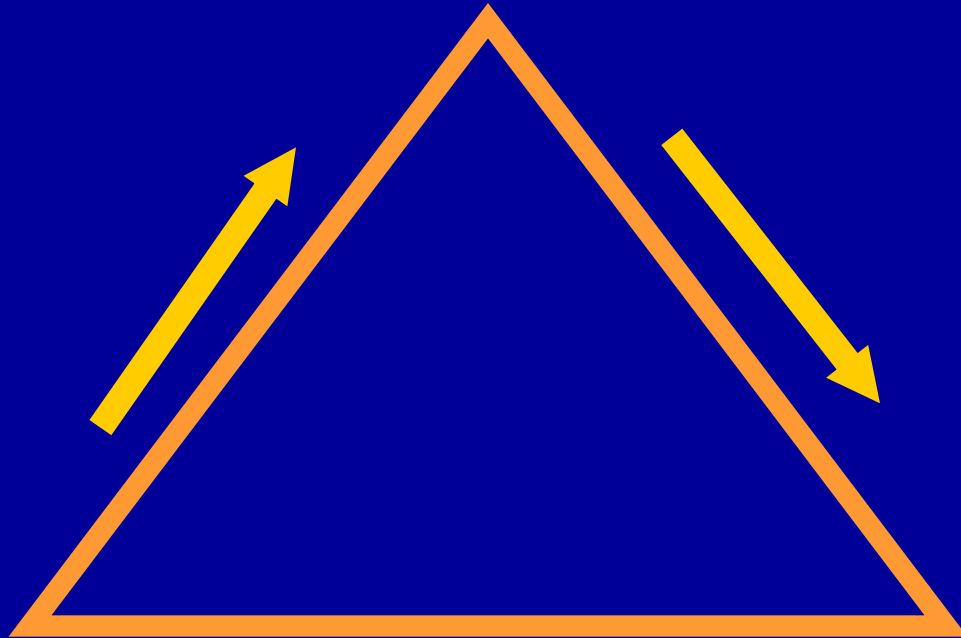
