T20 Stocktaking

- What has the T20 achieved
 - → Compiling and catalyzing production of literature Australian T20 Presidency

 - upon demand: Global Skills Accelerator note for G20 Employment Working Group
 - self-initiated: Infrastructure paper, Sovereign Debt Restructuring paper
 - → Website = bringing together G20 works
 - T20 papers (joint)
 - Active blog to reflect individual perspectives
 - Links to other relevant papers and reports
- How can we improve the procedures?
 - → Better coordination of network
 - → Establish permanent working groups not only one time collaboration for joint papers

The Global Policy Dialogue Platform

- Organize the annual Global Policy Dialogue Platform conference in collaboration with the annual T20 coordinator and G20 Presidency
- Expand and maintain the virtual network by bringing in key institutions and experts
- Manage the content of the virtual network by coordinating activities, continuously updating themes, and encouraging participation
- Facilitate collaboration between network partners that create bilateral, multilateral partnerships between, think tanks, and the variety of G20 perspectives represented in C20, B20, etc.
